

138 Grants, \$1,004,772 Funded!

This year is unlike any other; COVID-19 has impacted everyone and everything, including our grant programs. In the past 11 months we have received grant requests for \$2.3 million from North Shore charities. Some Community Grant recipients were unable to proceed with their programs, many had to modify programming and others have seen an incredible increase in demand for their services. The **Neighbourhood Small Grant** (NSG) program, typically consisting of projects that bring neighbours together, was modified to the Responsive NSG program and events went online and virtual.

In mid-March we launched the North Shore COVID-19 Emergency Response Fund. The Government of Canada introduced the Emergency Community Support Fund in May and October, which saw the Foundation granting to charities in North and West Vancouver. To date, over \$650,000 has been raised in donations from 180+ amazing community members, plus the Government of Canada, for COVID granting on the North Shore.
